2 Facebook engagement with children has doubled during the virus lockdown. Seek God’s guidance for even more online children’s resources.

3 “My son is addicted to drugs. Pray for him to accept Jesus as his God and to be freed from this destructive addiction.” Egypt

4 Thank God for the freedoms enjoyed in the United States, but remembering that freedom is only fully found in Christ alone.

5 Give thanks that even during the COVID-19 pandemic, viewers can worship with SAT-7 televised services.

6 Thank God for SAT-7’s mission to make His love visible in the MENA region.

7 Pray that whole families will receive character-shaping messages from the fictional stories read on *My Story* on SAT-7 KIDS.

8 Pray that *Answers of Hope* on SAT-7 TÜRK is effective in answering the increasing number of questions about God and faith.

9 Ask God to direct the launch of the new SAT-7 PARS app allowing viewers to stream programs live and to connect to counselors 24/7.

10 “I learned we should not only eat food but also be nurtured from the Bible. Pray other youth will also learn this from SAT-7.” Iran

11 “When I saw the child marriage clip, I remembered my own marriage. Pray for me to have strength to fight for my daughter.” Algeria

12 Give thanks for the extra efforts staff members have made to keep live broadcasts running during the COVID-19 lockdown.

13 Thank the Lord for the continued support of ministry friends who provide for the financial needs of SAT-7.

14 The second episode of *Our Story from Home* on SAT-7 KIDS reached 121,000 viewers on social media. Pray this program will be effective.

15 Seek God’s help to produce more SAT-7 programs to serve the growing Church in the MENA.

16 Pray the Lord will pour His wisdom and words through those who answer viewer questions.

17 “War and destruction and poverty seem endless. Pray for me to overcome these conditions and find a true source of hope.” Syria

18 “I am a new Christian. I want to meet another Christian, so we can talk. Ask God to help me find a Bible also.” Morocco

19 Pray that SAT-7 TÜRK programs continue to unify Turkish churches of different denominations across Turkey.

20 Ask the Holy Spirit to provide the right people to be on-screen for programs in Dari and Tajik dialect.

21 Seek the Holy Spirit’s guidance for all planning and recording for the new seasons that will begin broadcasting in September.

22 During lockdown, domestic violence has surged. Pray that SAT-7 family programs will help stem and reverse this trend.

23 Pray the Lord will draw viewers to *Essence of the Gospel* on SAT-7 TÜRK as a starting point in their search for a God of love and hope.

24 “Praise God for new Persian believers who were saved from their fear of death, found eternal life, and were granted new birth.” Europe

25 “I wanted to end my life. I asked SAT-7 TÜRK for a Bible to see what it said about suicide. Now I read it every day and have hope.” Turkey

26 Pray for the impact of *The Wall* on SAT-7 ARABIC on issues such as Freedom of Religion and Belief (FORB).

27 As COVID-19 affects ministries worldwide, pray that God will bless SAT-7’s Partners with continued strength, hope, and resources.

28 Plead for God’s comfort, strength, and effective witness for thousands of believers who are currently imprisoned and abused for their faith.

29 Three times weekly, *My School* on SAT-7 KIDS goes live on Facebook. Praise the Lord for the connections between teachers and children.
