Bahar is a SAT-7 TÜRK viewer who lived in the shadow of depression every day. She was divorced, unable to see her children, and struggling under the weight of loneliness.

Bahar started reading the Bible and reflecting on her life. Hope began to grow; she went to a church and later developed a personal relationship with Jesus. But she still suffered from depression. Her friends suggested she watch SAT-7.

### A matter of life and death

The channel became more than an encouragement to her. It was a lifeline.

"I was alone on the morning of my birthday," says Bahar. "I felt so lonely. I had a handful of pills in one hand with the desire to end my life, and I had the remote in my other hand. And I thought to myself that I would watch *Homemade* one last time and see what she (Semsa, the presenter) had to talk about.

"That day she was talking about God's love, patience, and in fact, delivering ourselves to God, delivering our grievances to Him. At that time, I thought to myself about how I was taught that ending your life is a sin. I wondered if it is the

same in the Bible. I asked myself and wondered how I could obtain a Bible.

“I then messaged you (the Audience Relations team), and you got back to me right away.”

## **Providing a Bible ... and hope!**

The SAT-7 Audience Relations team not only provided a Bible, but the personal follow-up supplied a newfound hope that Bahar desperately needed.

Sargez struggled with disillusionment because of the violence and profiteering he saw around him. One day he accidentally found the SAT-7 PARS channel.


