Isolation has been an unwelcome reality for many in the world over the last two years.

But for Christians in dangerous areas of the Middle East and North Africa, isolation is a common and desperate way of life.

"MAY THE WORD OF GOD, JESUS CHRIST, BE WITH YOU."

Abteen is a viewer who lives in Kabul, Afghanistan. He is also a

new believer who secretly watches the Bible-based programs on SAT-7 to learn about God and be encouraged by other Christians. He contacted the SAT-7 team to connect and share his story.

Message from a believer living in danger

"Greetings to you servants of the Lord, may the Word of God, Jesus Christ, be with you," he wrote.

"I am self-employed with four children, the eldest of whom is eight

years old. Like me, he loves the Word of the Lord broadcast via your television channel.

"I have been a believer for two years, and although I was unable to access your channel for the last two months, I have now found the means to watch the channel's programs.

"I WAS PREVIOUSLY A MUSLIM ..."

"After I let my son watch the film about the Lord Jesus, which I had downloaded, he kept asking that I show 'the film of the Lord Jesus' to him again. I then began to worry that he might tell someone at school or mention it to someone else, so I said it is a film about 'prophet Jesus' to make sure that he doesn't use the word 'Lord.'

"I was previously a Muslim, and I have not yet been baptized. There is a lot to the story of how I came to faith, but I worry about my kids.

"At one time, I would freely tell some people that Jesus Christ is our Saviour and Lord. **Now that the Taliban have come, I do not say anything."**

Though you may not travel into hostile territory to deliver a message of hope, SAT-7 broadcasts do. SAT-7 supporters can trust that their gifts make God's love visible to those who are hurting and alone—even in the darkest of times.
