"You can't fly a kite. You can't play football. You can't dance and sing."

Mikael — a SAT-7 partner and director and producer of Christian television programs — describes the oppression Afghan people face.

Having grown up in Afghanistan, Mikael is closely familiar with the hospitable Afghan culture. It's nothing like the war, control, and poverty that have become so common since the Taliban takeover.

"Westerners must realize the

Taliban are nothing like the Afghan people," he says.

The country is now a place where long-standing traditions are forbidden, girls cannot attend school past grade six, and people no longer have a reason to laugh. Mikael says, "You can't even imagine how oppressive and anti-woman the Taliban is."

If people in Afghanistan have any hope left for better days ahead, it's dwindling. But in a place where darkness is heavy, light is breaking

"Viewers can immediately change the channel and nobody knows they've been watching a Christian program."

Censorship and illiteracy are constant challenges. But the accessibility of television programming breaks down those barriers.

EARTHQUAKE UPDATE: How you're helping SAT-7 provide vital support


It's hard to grasp the devastation caused by the earthquakes in Türkiye (formerly Turkey) and Syria.

Millions of people are suffering in the aftermath. Homes, families, and livelihoods are destroyed. Nobody can prepare themselves for circumstances like these.


Together, we can share vital hope. With your support, SAT-7 TÜRK is bringing practical, psychological, and spiritual support to earthquake victims — especially women and children.
