"How?" Leen would ask. "Does Jesus do magic?"

It wasn't until Leen was invited to be a participant on a SAT-7 show that she discovered the answer that would transform her life.

OPENING UP ON A SAT-7 STAGE

Leen showed up to the SAT-7 studio for *You Are Not Alone*, a series that allows children to open up about their struggles and find hope, prayer, support, and a way forward with Jesus.

She was terrified to go on stage. But she was tired of hiding her secret — and hiding the thing that scared her most: dyslexia.

That day in front of the cameras, Leen spoke up about her fears for the first time.

"I want to be like all of you," she cried. "I want to be able to read and write."

That was also the day that Leen learned she wasn't alone.

BELIEVING IN JESUS

Suddenly 8-year-old Leen discovered there was

hope for her. She began to believe Jesus could help her overcome her biggest fear and weakness. Instead of working like magic that disappears in a moment, Jesus used Leen's moment in a SAT-7 studio to change her life forever.

Children all across the Middle East and North Africa are afraid — just like Leen was — that they are all alone with their pains, fears, and

> Now a teen, Leen is speaking up on behalf of the weak and marginalized such as refugees, people with special


