This was life before Christ for Shokoh.

Growing up, Shokoh *knew* about Jesus. “My mother was from a different religious background, and my father was a Christian,” says Shokoh. “He never told us we had to become Christians, but he always talked about Christ.”

But Shokoh didn't *know* Jesus. And living in Türkiye, she didn't know if she wanted to. Becoming a Christian meant becoming a social outcast. It would be stamped on her state identity card. Shokoh could confidently expect threats, vandalism, and discrimination in employment by following Jesus.

One day, the risk was no longer greater than the need in her heart.

Shokoh opened up to a Christian family member about everything – the nightmares, the painful

memories, the bitterness that ate away at her thoughts. It was making her physically sick. She desperately wanted to be healed in her mind and body.

The family member led Shokoh in a prayer for salvation – and all the stories she heard as a child about this Jesus became real. The love she longed for, the comfort she craved, the peace she prayed for. She finally found it.

FREEDOM IN FORGIVENESS

Hungry to grow in her new faith, Shokoh joined a Persian-speaking church. And thanks to you, she had a steady presence encouraging her to go deeper with God. “With the help of SAT-7, I began to grow and learn,” she says.

And soon, things in Shokoh's life that used to bother her became unimportant.

“I've changed in many ways,” she says. “Convenient lies no longer mean anything to me. Anger has given way to patience. Distrust has

been replaced by trust only in the Lord. Hearing God's voice, overcoming past and present pains, and laying them at the foot of the cross have turned darkness into light.”

God is moving mightily in Shokoh's life. The most powerful change she's experienced? Forgiveness. The miracles it has brought to her life will fill you with faith . . .

“I'm forgiving people who I never knew how to forgive,” says Shokoh. “For years, I did not forgive my ex-husband. When I learned to forgive, I no longer had nightmares. I did not become weak or ill. I was not resentful.

I could describe the good taste of forgiveness while sharing the Gospel. ***I can say how sweet it is.***”

Shokoh was able to “taste and see that the Lord is good” (Psalm 34:8) because you opened the door to God's redeeming love and forgiveness – all through satellite broadcasting and on-demand streaming!
