In a land of war and destruction, you filled Bashir's home with the peace of Jesus.

Bashir daydreamed of packing up his family, getting on a plane, and fleeing Syria forever.

His home country is beautiful – deeply rooted in generosity and hospitality. Guests, even strangers, are invited in for tea and meals. Music, dance, and art are everywhere. Family is the cornerstone of Bashir's culture.

So why would he want to run?

"I dream of safety and stability," said Bashir. "I'm hoping for a life of peace and tranquility."

Behind Syria's rich culture, most of the population live below the poverty line. Electricity, food, and work are sporadic. The mark of war can't be scrubbed – it lingers in unexploded weapons, rubble, and conflict in neighboring countries. Thousands are displaced, living in tents and shelters within refugee camps.

And refugees who do finally return to their home? Their houses are nothing more than empty shells.

You can understand why Bashir wants to flee with his family. Because he's running from a pile-up

of relentless conflict, a collapsing economy, and daily danger.

ONE HOUR OF PROGRAMMING CHANGED EVERYTHING

When Bashir came across SAT-7, the words and worship on the screen felt like a flicker of hope in his living room. He didn't know peace could survive in impoverished conditions – but here it was on his TV. *Real peace.*

Bashir reached out to our team – made up of loving and mature Christians who answer viewer questions, offer live prayer, and offer a chance to say "yes" to Jesus. Regular conversations kept him connected with a source of truth. The SAT-7 team welcomed him, listened to him, and prayed through his fears with him.

Then, after several conversations about the love of God, Bashir heard the Good News and accepted a relationship with Jesus.

What he said next will move your heart.

"I'LL KEEP THIS PRAYER IN MY HEART. AND I WILL TEACH IT TO MY CHILDREN."

"I'll keep this prayer in my heart. And I will teach it to my children."

BUILDING GENERATIONAL FAITH

Your generosity opens the door to renewal that spreads across generations. Bashir and his family may have gone their entire lives without interacting with a Christian and hearing the Gospel. But because you give, he – and now his children – will know the joy and redemption of walking with Christ.

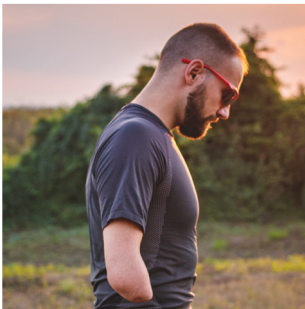

A SAT-7 SHOW IS GIVING A VOICE TO PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES



A person living with a disability in the Middle East and North Africa is navigating more than just physical challenges. They're navigating a world that often refuses to make room for them.

They face poverty at rates far higher than their neighbors. Denied education, work, and a place in community. But through a SAT-7 TÜRK program, you're changing the narrative to reflect the truth – everyone is an image-bearer of God with gifts to offer the world.

REAL STRUGGLES, REAL STORIES, REAL WORTH

Obstacle Overcomers, a series challenging disability stigmas, is set to release a new season in 2026. Across its episodes, the show introduces viewers to real people with real challenges – like world champion para-swimmer Beytullah from Türkiye.

“When people learn I’m a national athlete, their reaction changes completely,” says Beytullah, who was born without arms. “It shouldn’t take medals for someone to respect you. I wasn’t strong because of medals. I became strong long before that.”

Champion para-athletes aren’t the only guests on the series. Episodes star parents raising children with cerebral palsy, thriving adults on the autism spectrum, and more stories of strength.

“Every story helps change the community’s perspective of those with disabilities and becomes a light that gives encouragement and hope to everyone who is watching,” says a presenter on the show. “Each life story becomes a tangible reflection of the love of Christ – because Christianity is the revelation of God’s strength when we feel weak.”
