But in the middle of this exciting time, Rouba began struggling with an unknown illness. Experiencing depression and anxiety, she went to a psychiatrist. Students at school began bullying her for it . . .

"They'd make fun of me, thinking I was mentally ill or crazy," Rouba says. "I no longer trusted myself."

Rouba was wrestling with challenges that far too many other children face.

FINDING HER COURAGE

When Rouba first started on SAT-7's *Challenge Accepted*, she felt afraid and shy. The director and producer saw Rouba's potential and told her she had the talent to be a presenter on a live show – not just a pre-recorded show like *Challenge Accepted*.

Rouba struggled to believe it. "I wish I could see what they are seeing in me," she told herself. "I wish I could have more self-confidence."
